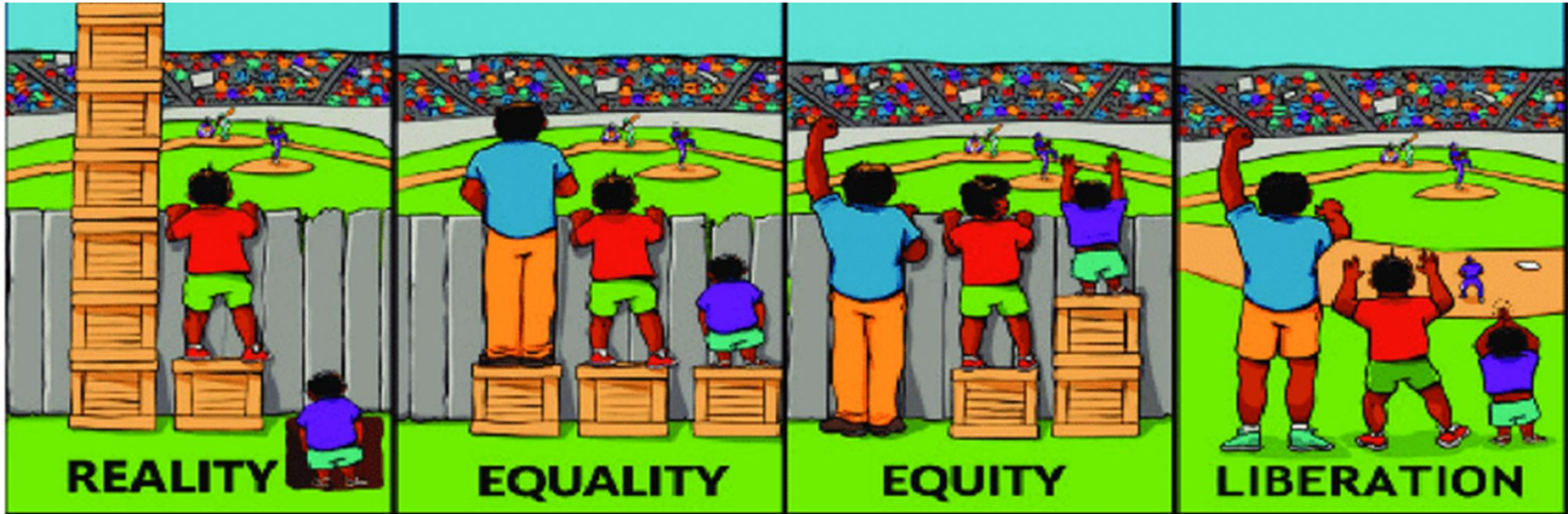

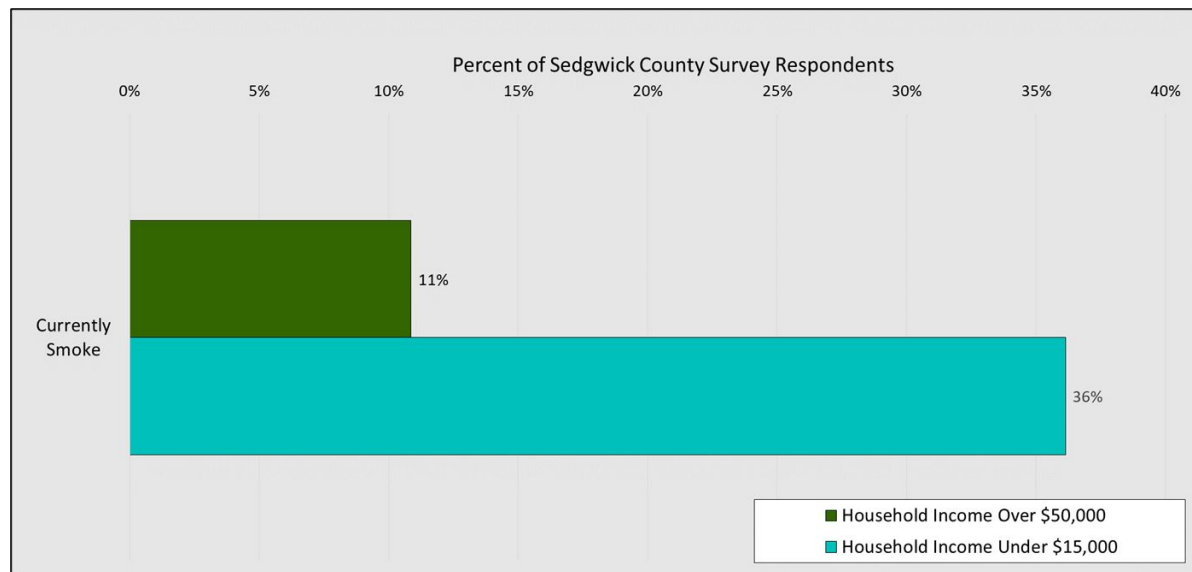

SDOH

IMPACT OF SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH

Social determinants of health have tremendous affect on an individual's health regardless of age, race, or ethnicity.



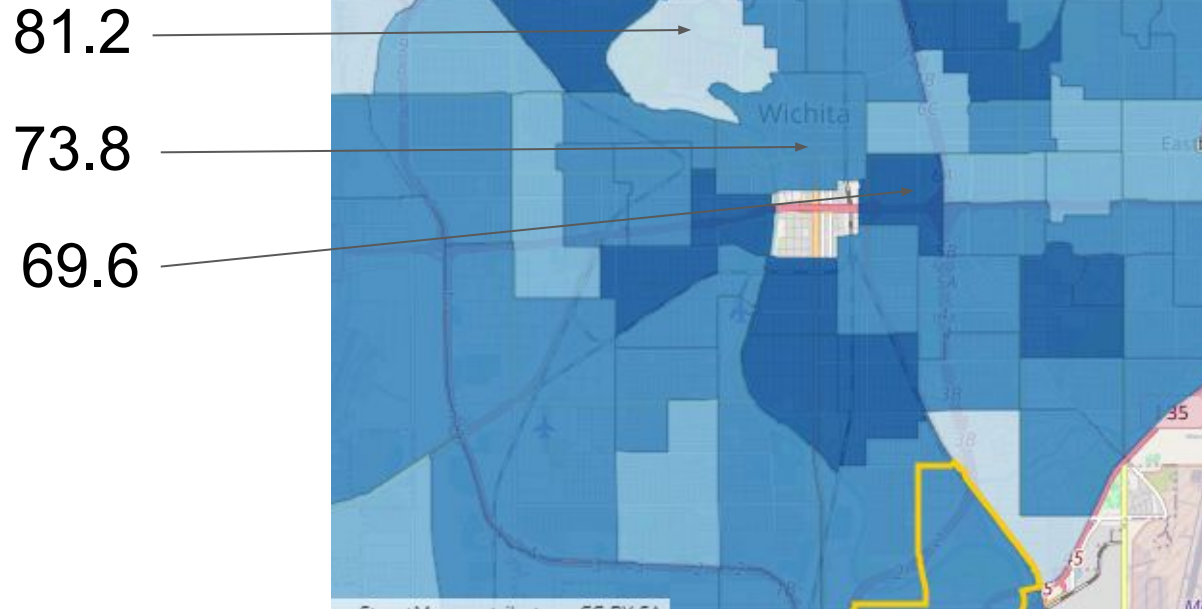
➤ SDOH Impact

- ➔ **20 percent** of a person's health and well-being is related to **access to care** and **quality of services**
- ➔ The **physical environment, social determinants** and **behavioral factors** drive **80 percent** of health outcomes

Health Data Community Health Assessment

A **Community Health Assessment** gives organizations comprehensive information about the community's current health status, needs, and issues.





Health Data Community Listening Sessions - Lessons Learned

Question 2: Are there things that make it hard for you to be healthy?

Lack of resources, Finances, Mental health, Learned behaviors, Physical health

Question 4: What comes to mind when I say a healthy community?

Supportive community

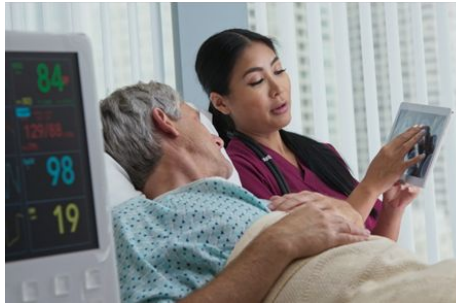

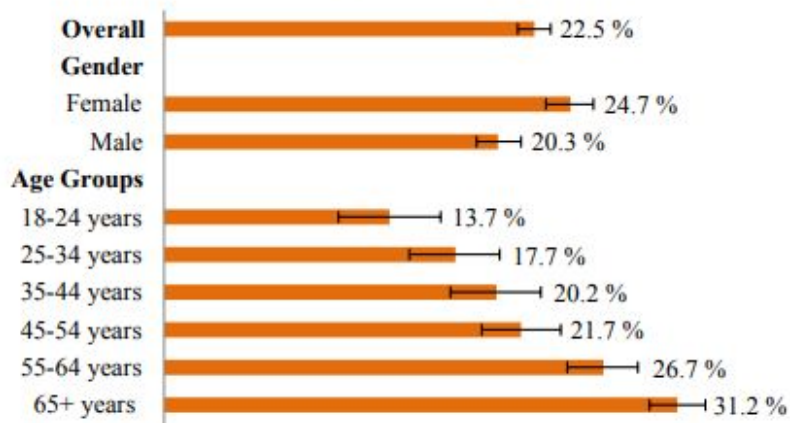
Health Data BREAKOUT / Discussion:

- **Birth Outcomes**
(infant mortality, low birth weight)
- **Education**
(graduation rates, higher education)
- **Environmental Health**
(radon, lead, air quality)
- **Family Planning**
(sexually transmitted infections and screenings, contraception)
- **Food Environment**
(food insecurity, free or reduced school lunches)
- **Health Care Access**
(insurance, basic medical care, etc.)
- **Housing**
(homelessness, severe housing problems)
- **Mental Health**
(depression, suicide, gambling)
- **Obesity and Diabetes**
(walkability, physical inactivity)
- **Poverty**
(income, unemployment)
- **Substance Misuse**
(drugs, alcohol, smoking, vaping)
- **Unintentional Injury**
(motor vehicle accidents, drowning, falls)
- **Violence and Crime**
(bullying, domestic violence, homicide)

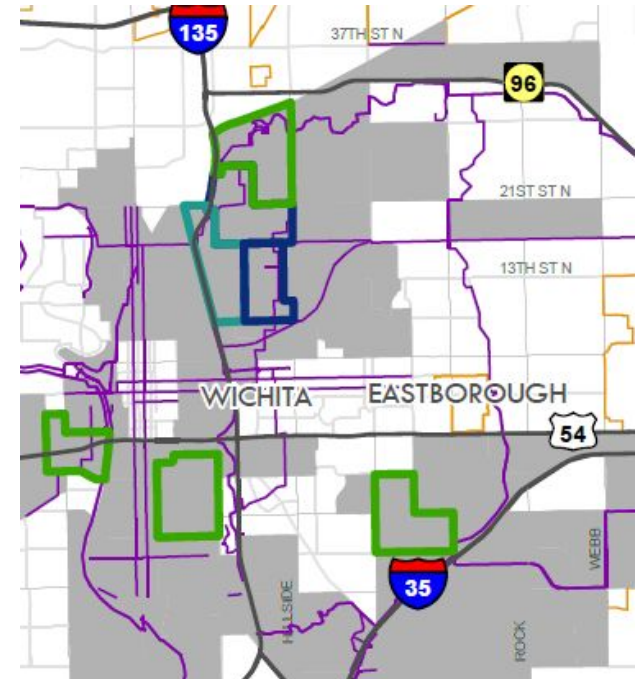

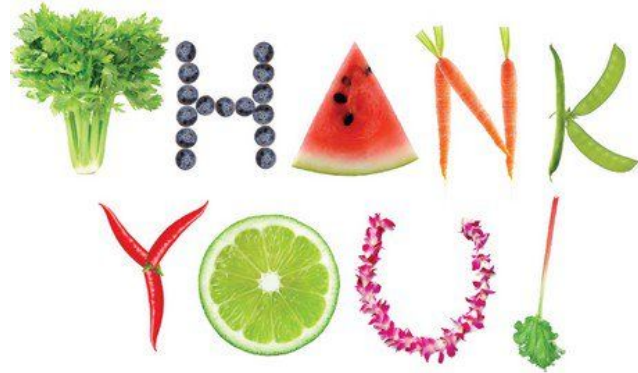
