<u>Our mission:</u> Promote physical activity and good nutrition for every generation living in the greater Wichita area through people, programs, and policies.


1. Welcome & Coalition Updates

 - In 2020 approximately 1 in 9 Kansans reported being diagnosed with diabetes.
 - According to the American Diabetes Association, diabetes costs Kansas approximately 2.4 billion dollars in direct medical expenses and indirect costs (loss of productivity due to diabetes) each year.
